Soap Making Workshop Supplies (Class # 1377)

Please bring the following with you to class:

Small deep mixing bowl

1-2 quart size. No larger. It should hold 3 cups of liquid comfortably but not be much bigger. Stainless steel, glass, enamel or plastic only. No aluminum or tin allowed. A deep container is best, shallow ones don't produce good results.

Measuring cup

Must be glass, 4 cup capacity is best, 2 cup is OK.

Thermometer

A candy or candle thermometer won't work because they are not accurate enough. It is the same with a standard meat thermometer. They don't work in soap making because they don't accurately measure a temperature, they only measure approximate temperatures. Purchase a thermometer with a stainless steel shaft with a dial on top. It must accurately measure between 0-220°F so that you could measure 72° or 96° or 107°. Digital ones are the most accurate.

Large wire whisk

No rust allowed

Rubber spatula

For scraping the bowl

Rubber gloves

These are required to participate in workshop. They can be yellow kitchen style or medical gloves.

Safety goggles

Not required but a really good idea.

Soap mold

Clean, dry 1 quart milk or juice carton and a large clip to close the top Do not use if container is lined in silver (aluminum). This is common with soy milk containers.

Large bath towel

Newspaper

Several thick sheets to cover work area

Wear old clothes with long sleeves or bring a long sleeved smock. No open toed shoes or sandals.

All items may be used again in the kitchen after a thorough cleaning.
